COLDS AND H1N1 FLU

Know The Difference Between Cold and H1N1 Flu Symptoms

<u>Symptoms</u>	<u>Cold</u>	<u>H1N1 Flu</u>
Fever	Fever is a rare with a cold.	Fever is usually present with the flu in up to 80% of all flu cases. A temperature of 100F or higher for 3 to 4 days with the flu.
Coughing	A hacking, productive (mucus producing) cough.	A non-productive (non-producing) Cough is usually present with the flu.
Aches	Slight body aches and pains can be part of a cold.	Severe aches and pains are common with the flu.
Stuffy Nose	Stuffy nose is commonly present with a cold and typically resolves spontaneously within a week.	Stuffy nose is not commonly present with the flu.
Chills	Chills are common with a cold.	60% of people experience chills.
Tiredness	Tiredness is fairly mild with a cold.	Tiredness is moderate to severe with the flu.
Sneezing	Sneezing is commonly present with a cold.	Sneezing is not common with the flu.
Sudden Symptoms	Cold symptoms tend to develop over a few days.	The flu has a rapid onset within 3-6 hours. The flu hits hard and includes sudden symptoms like high fever, aches and pains.

<b>Headache</b>	<b>A headache is fairly uncommon with a cold.</b>	<b>A headache is very common with the flu, present in 80% of flu cases.</b>
<b>Sore Throat</b>	<b>Sore throat is commonly Present with a cold.</b>	<b>Sore throat is not commonly present with the flu.</b>
<b>Chest Discomfort</b>	<b>Chest discomfort is mild to moderate with a cold.</b>	<b>Chest discomfort is often severe with the flu.</b>
